## *Local Bicycle Club Donates to Dare to Care Food Bank*

The Southern Indiana Wheelmen (SIW) bicycle club has donated \$2,000 to Dare to Care Food Bank. This is the second year they have made a \$2,000 donation. The money was raised from the Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour on October 1, in Lanesville, Indiana. “This was the 44th year of the Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour and unfortunately, our numbers were down a little from last year. However, our sponsorship was up from last year so we were able to donate the same amount as 2021”, said David Campbell, president of the club.

“Dare to Care supports several food pantries in southern Indiana, where we primarily ride, and we felt this was the organization to support.” Kate Chandler, representative for Dare to Care added, “This donation will provide over 6,000 meals to people in need in our communities. Access to nutritional foods is a basic human right, and we’re incredibly grateful to our Southern Indiana partners like SIW, for their continued support.”

The 44th Harvest Homecoming Bicycle Tour took place in Lanesville, Indiana where it has been since 2019. Over 350 riders participated in the event riding the 25, 40, or 65-mile course through scenic southern Indiana. The 2023 Harvest Homecoming Bicycle tour is currently in the planning stages.
