I encourage all of us to continue to focus on riding safely. I am a fan of riding in highly visible apparel and of using active lighting. While I almost always have my Garmin Varia tail light on, I am working on more consistently using active forward lighting regardless of the time of day. While I have room for improvement, I regularly remind myself to drive and ride defensively and to remain calm in difficult situations.
